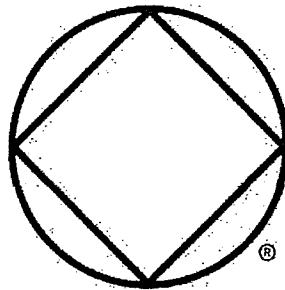

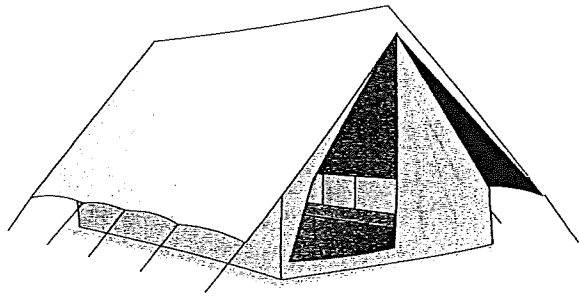
- 3) How many members are in your group with physical impairments? This is members that use a walker, cane, scooter, wheelchair and/or mobility service dog?

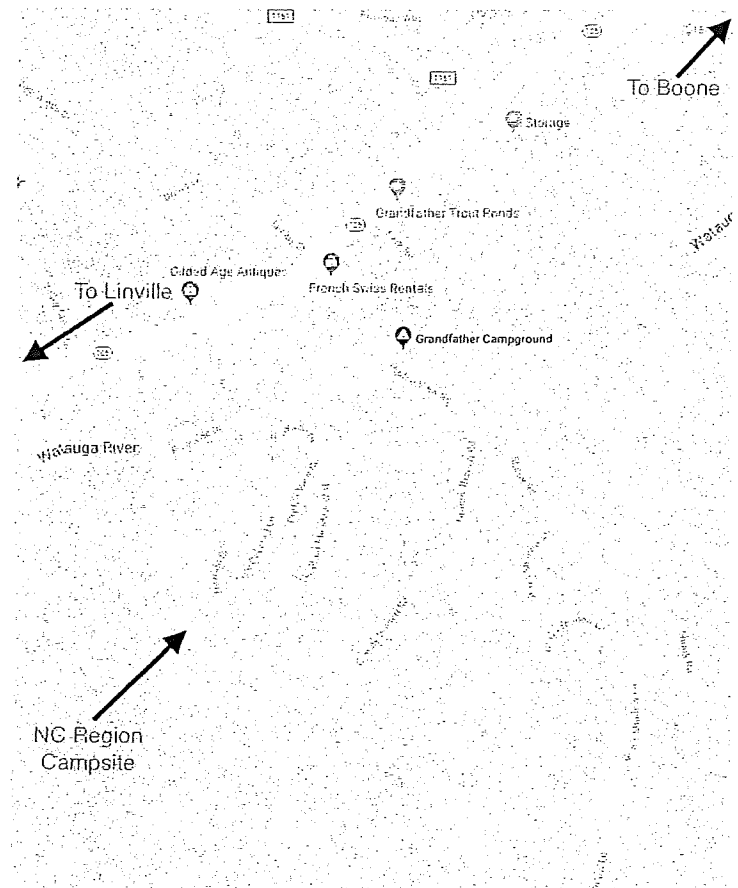

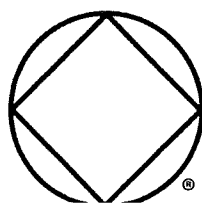
