After a lengthy phone call with Danny, it was explained to me that we need not submit a list of operators to region but to simply continue to pass our cell phone around amongst us as we have been doing and the calls would automatically be forwarded to our phone. So now my question is do we phase out our 800 number and continue to utilize the statewide helpline number? and if so do we try to set a deadline for this transition? Or do we continue to leave things the way they are? To transition in a timely manner would be more cost effective in that it would lessen our monthly expenses by whatever the monthly cost of our helpline number is with our CenturyLink account.
